That the Town of Raymore has discussed the water bill at 521 1st Ave. due to a burst water pipe in the basement the bill for the 1st quarter is higher than normal and that the Town will not adjust or abate any amount of the bill.

FURTHERMORE, THAT the town is not responsible for any water or sewer lines from the curb stop to the property, that is the responsibility of the home owner and it should have been physically inspected more frequently.
